A Word From Pastor Steve

Winter is upon us, and we find ourselves buried in snow and cold temperatures. This has away of upending many of our scheduled services and programs. It is important that you stay tuned to our Facebook and check your emails where our cancellation announcements are made. We will do our best to keep everyone updated on these changes.

Due to the cold weather last Sunday, it gave us the perfect opportunity to have both in-person worship and for the members and friends who remained at home, to check out our live stream. Mark Pudwill and Brad Pope have worked hard to tweak and improve the streaming quality over the past few months. The church invested over \$10,000 in improving our equipment and technology to make this happen. Most Sundays only average around 23 viewers, but last Sunday it was 49.

I want to encourage you to use our live stream as a tool to invite others to join us at Second Baptist. Many times, people aren't ready to simply show up on a Sunday morning and participate, because they don't know what to expect or what they are getting into. If you invite them to watch our live stream, they can get a taste for Second Baptist, and later may decide to attend.

Let me say, however, that live stream should never be our primary means of worship unless we are physically incapable of attending. In other words, don't make live stream your worship experience unless you absolutely have to. There is something missing when you can not be present in worship with other believers. I compare it to the act of staring at a picture of a Hershey bar as opposed to having a Hershey bar, unwrapping it, and biting off a piece. Being present in worship is tasting the sweet community of fellowship we find in the church.


